Permaculture: A way to Renovate Traditional Entrepreneurship

From 19th to 23rd of October, 2020 it took place in Verona (Italy) a Participatory Visit part of the Erasmus+ project: 'PARTE- Permaculture: A way to Renovate Traditional Entrepreneurship (2019-2-ES02-KA205-013620).

During the visit, participants of the 3 entities were able to exchange their best practices, tools and tips on green entrepreneurship in line with the permaculture principles.

Besides, participants were able to visit **Vccari Cav.** where they met a historical local entrepreneur who is trying to adopt a transition towards renewable energy and recycling. After that, they visited the **Gabanel Bike Hostel**, a Villa which is part of a Municipal social recovery plan, managed by an NGO, to transform the build into a hostel designed on eco-principles and inclusive architecture, adapting the structure to disable users.

In addition, they met **Progettomondo.mlal**, an NGO which work is mainly developed in South America and focused on solving problems such as suffering from social, environmental, economic depression. Finally, participants had a meeting with a member of **GEN** (Global Ecovillage Network) who talked about their projects based on the topic of Green Entrepreneurship and how it is approached by a wide network of different communities that work on the next level of sustainability: Regeneration.

Through this activity, the participants were able to acquire new skills and knowledge on Permaculture, responsible and local entrepreneurship, development and management of projects based on green and social responsibility.
